The hub serves local youth as a fully integrated one-stop-shop, where youth between the ages of 12 and 25 can address all of their health and wellness needs. Immediate help is available for mental health, addiction, primary care services, peer support, system navigation and many other community and social services, all delivered in a timely and integrated manner from one central hub. **No appointment is required.**



WHAT TO EXPECT BY BECOMING A MEMBER OF OUR GREAT TEAM:

- Participate with youth and other members
- Participate in decisions on services and activities offered in the hub
- Attend 6-8 meetings a year
- Supported and mentored by a member agency to help ease the transition into this leadership role
- Your participation on the Hub Alliance is voluntary; however, youth and family members will receive a recognition of \$10/hour or youth can receive volunteer hours towards their high school diploma
- Travel expenses will be reimbursed
- Food and beverages will be provided at the meetings
